1. Theme 거리 [geori] STREET and DISTANCE

거리¹ 비교적 큰길들이 이어져서 오가는 사람이나 차량들이 많은 곳

street a thoroughfare(usually including sidewalks) that is lined with buildings

distance the property created by the space between two objects or points

Geori¹(streets) of the city and geori⁵(distance) between people are changing in the course of before and after the pandemic.

The streets in the city filled with crowds have turned into stillness and keeping a certain distance from one another is not an unusual scene. Because of social distancing, people must maintain physical separation and often split spaces with glass partitions.

We maintain this unprecedented and strange distancing where people avoid close contact inevitably.

The city's various spaces for communication and exchange are turning into places to be on guard, and buildings that nurtured activities and social consensus are now focusing on separation and protection.

The physical separation and limitation on the number of persons in most gatherings due to the pandemic reduce opportunities for social exchange. Despite this condition, however, people find different ways to connect with others through new technology.

How will our lives evolve moving forward while the streets of the city and the distance among people are changing?

The topic of the Busan Architecture & Urban Photo Exhibition 2021 is '(changed) Geori'.

With the following keywords - Geori¹(streets) of city, spatial Geori⁵(distance), psychological Geori⁵(distance) - the exhibition aims to embrace the changing view on architecture and city, the changing relations between people and their life.
